FAMILY FAITH FORMATION

Registration for Faith Formation and Sacramental preparation begins this weekend and ends on Sunday, September 20. Orientation Day is on Sunday, September 20 at 10 am. This year we will be implementing a family centered, home-based program, with families meeting at the parish once-a-month for catechesis. Families will receive a monthly packet of lessons to be completed at home. We are hopeful that this new paradigm will allow parents greater flexibility helping their children learn more about their Catholic faith and forming them as young disciples. The fees are \$45 per student, with a \$10 discount per student if fees are paid before the Orientation Day. Sacramental preparation fees are \$25, per student, \$20 if paid by September 20. The “official” 1st session is on Sunday, October 4 at 10 am. Please make sure to register your child as soon as possible so that we can accurately order books and supplies. **Please provide a copy of your child’s baptismal certificate, particularly if they are preparing for sacraments this year!**

We are no longer offering a high school confirmation program, due to a lack of resources. To get a better understanding of how the changes

for the Restored Order for Confirmation will affect your family, there is a sheet contained in the registration packet that illustrates the sacramental preparation plan over the next 5 years.
